#### **UTORMFA** makes remote work better.



#### **SIMPLE**

Two clicks for a safer login.



#### **FAST**

Self-enroll in minutes.



### **SECURE**

Organizations that use MFA are significantly less likely to experience a breach.



#### CONVENIENT


Access high security applications from home. No need to go into the office.

#### WHAT IS UTORMFA?

UTORMFA is the University of Toronto's multi-factor authentication solution.

UTORMFA adds an extra layer of security to your login, enabling you to work remotely with confidence.

UTORMFA verifies your identity using a second factor (like a mobile device) ensuring that only you can login.



### **HOW DOES IT WORK?**

UTORMFA's multi-factor authentication solution is provided by DUO, a mobile application.

When you login, a push notification is sent to your phone by DUO.



## WHEN DO I USE IT?

UTORMFA only activates when logging in from off-campus locations. Most users only need to authenticate once a day. Users accessing high security apps may need to authenticate more frequently.

## WHO CAN SELF-ENROLL?

All staff, faculty and librarians at the university can self-enroll in UTORMFA.

Self-enroll means that you can sign up for it yourself. Set aside 10 minutes to get set up.


#### WHAT DO I NEED?

You can self-enroll with an Apple or Android device.\*

**Android Supported Platforms:** Android 7.0 and greater

iPhone Supported Platforms: iOS 11.0 and greater.

Download the DUO app to get started.



If your device is not compatible, contact your local help desk for support.



#### Protect Your University of Toronto Account


Two-factor authentication enhances the security of your account by using a secondary device to verify your identity. This prevents anyone but you from accessing your account, even if they know your password.






#### **UTORMFA Backup Codes**

You can use them in the event that your primary authentication device is not available. Once you leave this website, you will not be able to access these codes. Please ensure you store them in a secure location!

These codes can be used by choosing the "Enter a Passcode" option on the UTORMFA Duo prompt. Instructions are available under the Mobile Device Passcode section of the "How-To" tab on the UTORMFA website.
